The submissions will be judged by a jury of faculty and practitioner's affiliated with NYIT. There will be a public Award Reception and Gallery Show of the finalists, hosted by the department of Interior Design and held at the NYIT Midge Karr Fine Arts Gallery, Old Westbury.

The subject for the competition will be "The Inside." Your submissions can include depictions, abstract or real of the "inside" of any object, space or construction. Submissions must be hand executed and can include drawing, drafting, painting, models, sculpture, collages and mixed media. Computer aided drawings and renderings are welcome, but must be integrated into a hand executed composition.

- You must be a high school Junior or Senior
- Applications must include a recommendation from a teacher or mentor
- Submittals must be no larger than 11"x17"

On the back of your work, please include:

- The title of the piece
- The media it is produced in
- The size of the original
- A 30 word description of the intent of the design
